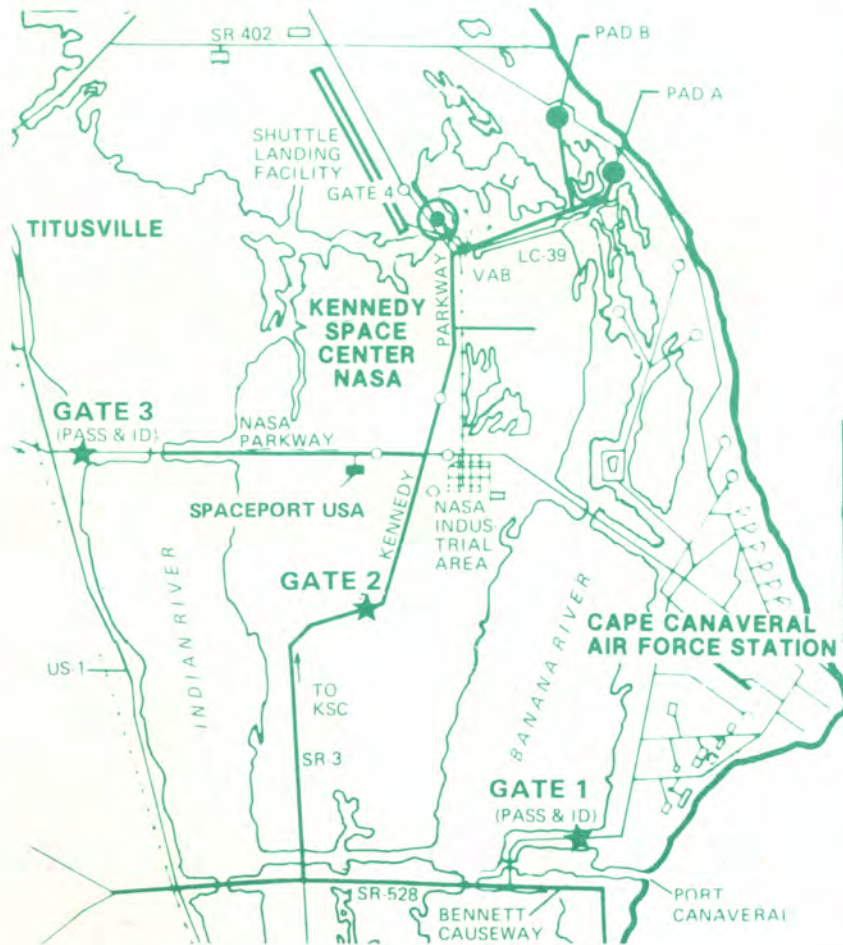

GATES 1,2&3 OPEN 3 HOURS BEFORE LAUNCH

Display in windshield with this side showing in vehicle.

This permit authorizes the bearer and vehicle occupants to enter Kennedy Space Center, FL., **ONLY** by gate No. 1 (south entrance to Cape Canaveral Air Force Station), by gate No. 2 (State Road No. 3 Merritt Island entrance), and by gate No. 3 (U. S. No. 1 and NASA causeway entrance) for the launch.

NOTE: Following launch or postponement of the launch please stay in place until notified and directed by KSC Security.

Cameras are allowed for use on launch day.
